RESTORATION

Good evening. During your time at this prayer station- we ask that you pray for restoration of God's kingdom, in individuals and evangelism.

During a church advisory board meeting, God sent an image of a person carrying a sheaf of wheat. The sheaf was so big that it was difficult to carry and some wheat was falling off – yet there was still more wheat to be harvested. The person who had this vision, understood it to mean that a great harvest was coming and that we need to prepare.

Pray for God's kingdom, for those who will come into the church and those who are sent out of the church.



THE PRODIGALS

Hello. At this prayer station, we would like you to pray for God to restore and save those whose lives are being wrecked through destructive behaviors like addiction.

During a church advisory board meeting, God sent an image of a person falling into a large pit with glass and metal shards at the bottom of the pit. The person was falling toward imminent danger and death. Then a large hook, like a fishhook or a shepherd's staff appeared and saved the person before they would hit the bottom and die.

Please pray for the lost, broken, prodigals, and for those struggling with addiction.
